

The Horseback Riding Program at Camp Sewataro

The riding instruction is English hunt seat riding lessons focused on the fundamentals of the rider's position and control of the mount. The program is suitable for riders who have never ridden up to riders who are cantering and jumping. Lessons are group lessons with a 1:1 ratio of staff to rider.

Riders must be 5 or older. We are sorry but no exceptions can be made to the age requirement.

Helmets and boots are provided or riders can bring their own. Riders must wear long pants. We do have some pants that can be borrowed. Riders have crates at the barn to leave their belongings for the week they are riding.

Please note: Riding lessons are scheduled during other camp activities. Riders will miss a camp activity to attend riding but lessons will not take place during swim lessons, free swim, boating, fishing or Adventure Challenge. If your child has an activity they do not want to miss, please note this below. We will do our best to schedule around this request but this cannot be guaranteed.

There are no refunds or make ups for absence or cancellation after May 30th. In the event that camp activities move to rainy day schedule or the Program Director determines that riding is unsafe due to the weather, riders will participate in a horsemanship lesson inside the barn. The riding portion cannot be rescheduled or refunded.

Space is limited and demand is high. It is recommended that you send payment with registration as lessons will not be scheduled until payment is received.
